



KEEP YOUR PET SPOOKTACULAR THIS HALLOWEEN!

Halloween is a fun time for you and your pet to dress up, but make sure to keep them safe with these tips from the American Veterinary Medical Association (AVMA).*

MAKE SURE TO TALK WITH YOUR VETERINARIAN ABOUT HOW TO MAKE THIS HALLOWEEN A GHOULISH GOOD TIME FOR YOU AND YOUR PET!

- 1) Don't give your pets candy, especially chocolate!
- 2) Make sure to have proper identification on your pet (microchip, collar and ID tag) in case your pet escapes while opening the door for trick-or-treaters.
- 3) Keep jack-o'-lanterns out of reach of your pets, especially if they contain an open flame.
- 4) Make sure your pet's costume fits properly and they are not able to tear off parts of the costume. This could lead to a choking hazard or worse.
- 5) Keep all glow sticks or Halloween jewelry out of reach. These can pose a choking hazard.
- 6) Make sure if your pet is helping to hand out candy or answer the door, they are comfortable with strangers. If a pet becomes anxious or uncomfortable with new people around, provide them a safe space to retreat to.
